Drives to properties to conduct appraisal work. Notes all new construction using property record cards (PRC's) and property maps.

Measures additions to existing dwellings and other structures. Notes new additions to existing dwellings and other structures.

Annotates PRC's for possible deletion of any dwellings or buildings that have been torn down or burned.

Notes obvious depreciation changes.

Measures new buildings amd makes sketches.

Checks property splits and line changes, noting improvements to each parcel.

Performs calculations on dwellings, barns, and other structures. Makes scaled corrections and additions to PRC's.

Organizes parcels for field review.

Other duties as required.
