

**27 June, 2011**

The Dale County Commission convened in regular session Monday, June 27, 2011. The following members were present: Judge Eunice Hagler, Chairperson; District One Commissioner Douglas M. Williamson; District Two Commissioner Steve McKinnon; District Three Commissioner Charles W. Gary and District Four Commissioner Kurt McDaniel.

Judge Hagler called the meeting to order at 6:00 p. m. Commissioner McKinnon opened with the Pledge to Allegiance. Commissioner Williamson followed with prayer.

APPROVED – MINUTES – JUNE 13, 2011 MEETING

Mr. McKinnon made a motion to approve the minutes of the June 13, 2011 meeting. Mr. McDaniel seconded the motion. All voted aye. Motion carried.

BID AWARDED – CHIP SEAL RESURFACING OF VARIOUS COUNTY ROADS

Upon recommendation of County Engineer Derek Brewer, Mr. McDaniel made a motion to award the bid for Chip Seal Resurfacing of Various County Roads to Charles E. Watts, Inc. for \$698,670.60. Mr. Gary seconded the motion. All voted aye. Motion carried.

BID AWARDED – VCT TILE – CIRCUIT CLERK'S OFFICE

Upon recommendation of Maintenance Supervisor John Dunn, Mr. Gary made a motion to award the bid for the VCT Tile for the Circuit Clerk's Office to Jackson's Carpet and Paint for \$2,668.00. Mr. McKinnon seconded the motion. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Mr. McKinnon made a motion to approve the disbursement of the County's appropriation to the Ozark-Dale County Economic Development Corporation as requested. Mr. McDaniel seconded the motion. All voted aye. Motion carried.
